Care Services for our Residents

We are continually working to improve the personal and medical care for our beloved residents! Below are services that we are now coordinating with:

- **Dispatch Health** is an urgent care service that comes to the home. We all know that a trip to the ER can be a disorienting & traumatizing experience for people with memory loss. Dispatch Health can provide medical treatment for conditions that don't require a hospital, but are needed more quickly than a future doctor visit. These conditions include suspected infections (sinus, UTI, sore throat, pink eye), allergic reactions in the skin, fever, flu, and more. They can also do IV fluids, prescribe meds and provide initial dosages. They are working on getting a POA release form so that the POA can sign in advance to approve a visit. At this time, they call the POA to get approval at the time of visit.

You may be thinking that this is an expensive service, but it is not! Medicare with a secondary is covered at 100%, with no secondary the max out-of-pocket expense is \$30. Innovage clients are fully covered, and those with Kaiser are charged their specialist co-pay. We hope to begin using this service if needed, with your approval of course. - **Dental hygienist** services by Olga Kogan of Senior Smiles are available at the house. She is an experienced and gentle hygienist who has provided teeth cleaning here for some of the residents. Teeth cleaning and cavity prevention is \$125, and digital dental x-rays are \$80. She discusses her evaluation with you and can make the appropriate referral to the dentist if needed. Please let us know if you would like to have your family member receive hygienist services.
